


- 1. Remove the B-pillar trim panel. For additional information, refer to B-Pillar Trim Panel in this section.
- 2. Fold down the rear seat.
- 3. **NOTE:** Inspect the shoulder safety belt guide cover for damage. If the shoulder safety belt guide cover is damaged or if it does not remain closed, install a new shoulder safety belt guide cover.

NOTE: Shoulder safety belt guide cover shown removed for clarity.

From behind the front shoulder safety belt guide cover, release the retaining tab and open the cover.




4. Remove the nut and shoulder safety belt guide.



- 6. Remove the safety belt anchor trim cover.








9. Remove the six luggage compartment back lower trim cover screws.




- 10. Remove the luggage compartment back lower trim cover.Remove the six pin-type retainers.


